Small secondary schools cited.

1. Robertsbridge School is in a rural location and the Authority has calculated that the costs of closure and alternative provision outweigh the costs of maintaining the school.
2. Testbourne School is a rural school with similar issues to Robertsbridge.
3. Miltoncross School, Portsmouth, is a new school with currently years 7 and 8 only on roll. It will rise to 1,000 pupils.
4. Causeway School, Eastbourne has an intake of 190 students per year, currently has years 7,8 & 9 on roll and will rise to 950 pupils.
5. The John Hunt of Everest School, Basingstoke has falling rolls and poor performance. Its main development plan target is to reverse the decline in numbers.
6. Fort Hill, Basingstoke has rising numbers and will take pupils from a large green field housing development nearby.
7. Oak Farm, Farnborough one of the lowest value added scores from KS3 to GCSE in the country and the curriculum does not fully comply with statutory requirements.
