Financial implications

There is financial provision for the rebuilding of the Pavilion as a result of the initial insurance claim £120k and a further sum allocated from the Property Improvement Fund £40k 2003-04.

The best tender price returned of £213k exceeds the currently allocated funds. At this time there is no additional funding identified from within existing environment revenue budgets.
