10.1 The Committee considered a report of the Interim Director of Housing that gave information on the progress of the outturn of the affordable housing developments funded by the Council & Housing Corporation during 2006/07 and advised on Members of the National Affordable Housing Programme administered by the Housing Corporation for Brighton & Hove for 2007/08 and the Key Worker Living Scheme (for copy see minute book). Councillor Randall, seconded by Councillor Allen proposed an amendment that the Committee express its continued support for the 40% Affordable Housing Scheme.
