109.1 The Committee considered a report of the Director, Environment which gave details of the process for achieving Fairtrade City status (for copy see Minute Book). The Chair reported that Unison supported the initiative.

(2) That the **Sustainability Commission** be allocated responsibility to work in partnership with a local Fairtrade Steering Group;

(3) That the option of having Fairtrade tea and coffee in all Council offices and buildings and at all Council meetings be fully evaluated.
