- (i) procure and award a contract for five (5) years for the provision of a ***7 day per week*** street outreach service for rough sleepers ~~to the value of £450,000 per annum;~~
  - (ii) with the potential for adding the staffing and management of severe weather provision for rough sleepers;
  - (iii) to approve an extension to the contract referred to in 2.1(i) for a period or periods of up to two years in total if it is deemed appropriate and subject to available budget; and
  - (iv) to report back to Housing Committee the progress and outcomes of this service.
