The data used for this analysis was crime data from the recording systems of Sussex Police and covers 12 months between 01/05/2021 and 30/04/2022.

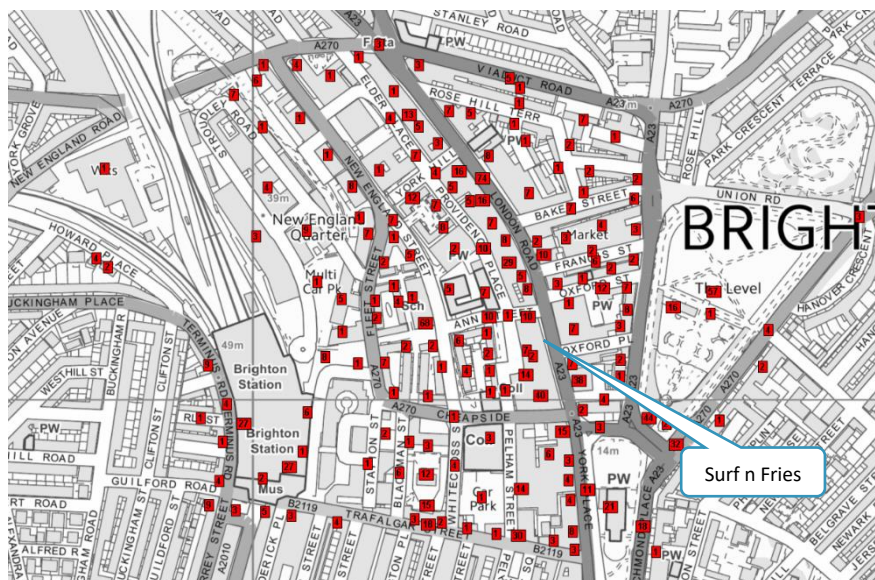
'No crimes' and offences committed out of force were removed from the dataset.

What offences are being committed in the surrounding area?

In the last 12 month period between 01/05/2021 – 30/04/2022 there have been 1,234 recorded crimes in London Road and the surrounding area.

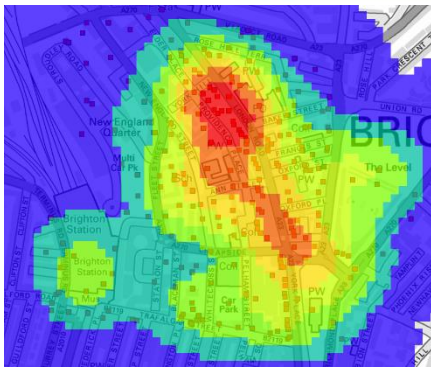
