Thank you for your time on Tuesday afternoon.

I have noted that currently no licensable activities are taking place on site as the restaurant isn't open yet and have made a note for another visit to the restaurant later this year once you're fully up and running.

As discussed during the inspection please can you action the following:

- 1. Ensure that you have the correct measures of beer, wine and spirits available (reference point 6 of mandatory conditions on the licence relating to supply of alcohol)
- 2. Display these measures on your menus and/or price list.
- 3. An incident and refusals log will be maintained by the premises showing a detailed note of incidents and refusals that occur. This log needs to be inspected and signed off by yourself once a month. The log should be kept for two years. Please let me know if you need one of ours provided, as I can put one in the post for you.
- 4. Display a notice by your door asking customers to leave the premises quietly and to have respect for local residents and other premises. You can find templates of these signs available to purchase on the Internet.
- 5. Signage advertising the 'Challenge 25' policy needs to be displayed in the restaurant. This can also be written on your menus somewhere.

I hope the above all makes sense. Good luck with the restaurant opening, and I shall visit again later in the year to see how you're getting on.
