#### THE DECISION

- That the Council withdraw denominational transport as defined in paragraph
  5.2 of the report from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2013; and
- (2) That the Council provides protection for older pupils at Cardinal Newman School who have bus passes and who have already started an examination course, until completion of that course.

### **REASON FOR THE DECISION**

The City Council must review its policies, in this case an aspect of home to school transport policy, with regard to cost effectiveness and equalities matters. The financial pressures facing the Council and the need to make long term savings in the home to school transport budget suggest that it is appropriate to determine whether to withdraw denominational transport or not.

### DETAILS OF ANY ALTERNATIVE OPTIONS

The Council could decide to retain the current transport policy for denominational transport at a cost of  $\pounds$ 74,209.20 pa. This should be balanced against the financial pressures facing the Council and the perceived inequality arising from the current policy.
