The Panel has agreed to issue a Street Trader License subject to the Council's standard street trader conditions. The Panel also wished to add conditions to the License restricting trade to 08:00 to 20:00; the consent would be for a mobile food outlet only, serving hot and cold food and hot and cold non alcoholic beverages. The Panel reminded the applicant that the consent is for 12 months and can be reviewed or revoked at anytime.
