I would like to ask this committee if they are concerned: that the number of treatments the CCG is proposing to remove from NHS provision has increased from 39 to 107, and that the list is now open-ended; that, when told a particular procedure is not available, patients will face a choice: pay and go private, or go without, which will greatly increase health inequality; that "noting" what NHS England and the CCG are doing to our NHS may not be an adequate response if we want to prevent the creation of a two-tier health service.
