

The Kingscliffe Society's**List of the benefits to Pride in moving the PVP down onto Madeira Drive for 2019**

- 50 Moving the PVP will produce massive administration and cost savings by the reduction in informing, dealing plus the public meeting by not having to deal with the 4,000 +'s residents, guest houses and business.
- 51 Better control of their public toilets and cleaning up afterwards, with less costs
- 52 Far less costs in barricading off the 16 residential side streets.
- 53 Therefore no cost of staffing the residential street and barricades
- 54 No cost of cleaning the 16 residential side streets
- 55 Better Policing of the venue by the high level overlooking from Marine Parade at far less costs
- 56 Better entry control over drugs and drink into venue.
- 57 Better facilities and space on Madeira Drive for the PVP, setting up and taking down costs
- 58 Far less cost of cleaning up following the PVP as no shop fronts to take care of from toilet spillage. Large truck cleaners can be used such as those use for the seafront runs, instance cleaning!
- 59 Less requirement for late night council staff to oversee residential noise problems from the PVP & venues.
- 60 Less cost of vehicle barricades.
