- 2.1 Agrees to extend the current Youth Service Grants Programme and to fund the work of current recipients for a further six months from 1 October 2020 to 31 March 2021, subject to funding being agreed in the 2020/21 budget.
- 2.2 Agrees to a review of the provision of youth services across the city which will consider the areas set out in paragraph 4.1 of this report and that the findings of the review are brought back to Committee in June 2020. This timing may need to change depending on Government funding announcements.
- 2.3 Agrees that the terms of reference of the review be agreed by a cross party group of councillors and Youth Wise.
