I SAY as follows

On Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> November I met **REDACTED** at her house to see a performance at the **REDACTED** (**REDACTED**). I arrived around 6.30-6.45 to get to **REDACTED** for 7pm. The music from the Paris House was extremely loud as I walked past, and I was surprised to still hear very loud music in **REDACTED** Kitchen/ diner with the front door and window shut. It seems incredible to me that a pub is allowed to play music so loud that it can be clearly heard inside my friend's house on a residential street. I would be totally stressed if I had to live close by and listen to this repeatedly. Having lived with a noisy neighbour, I know how it affects you just anticipating the noise even when it's quieter, so would find it very stressful cumulatively.
