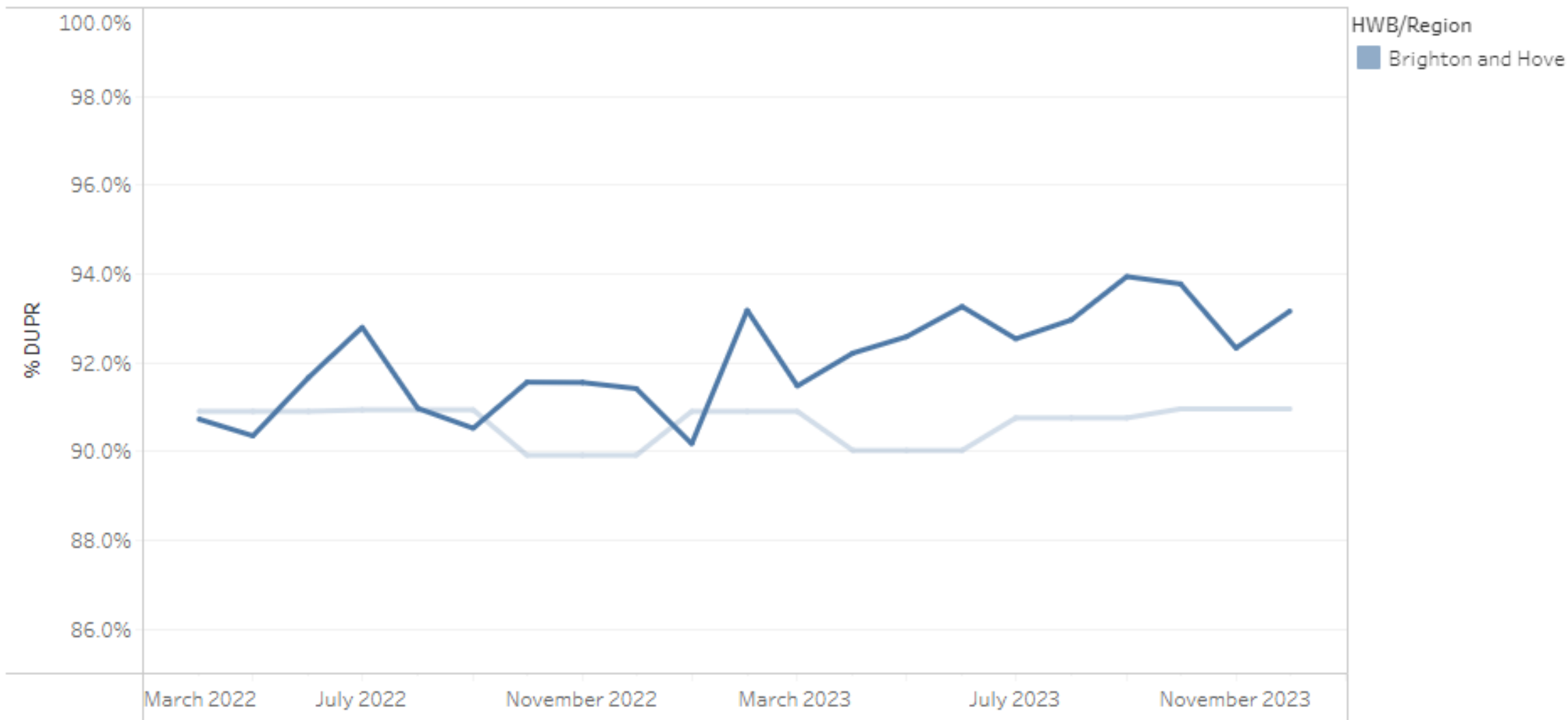


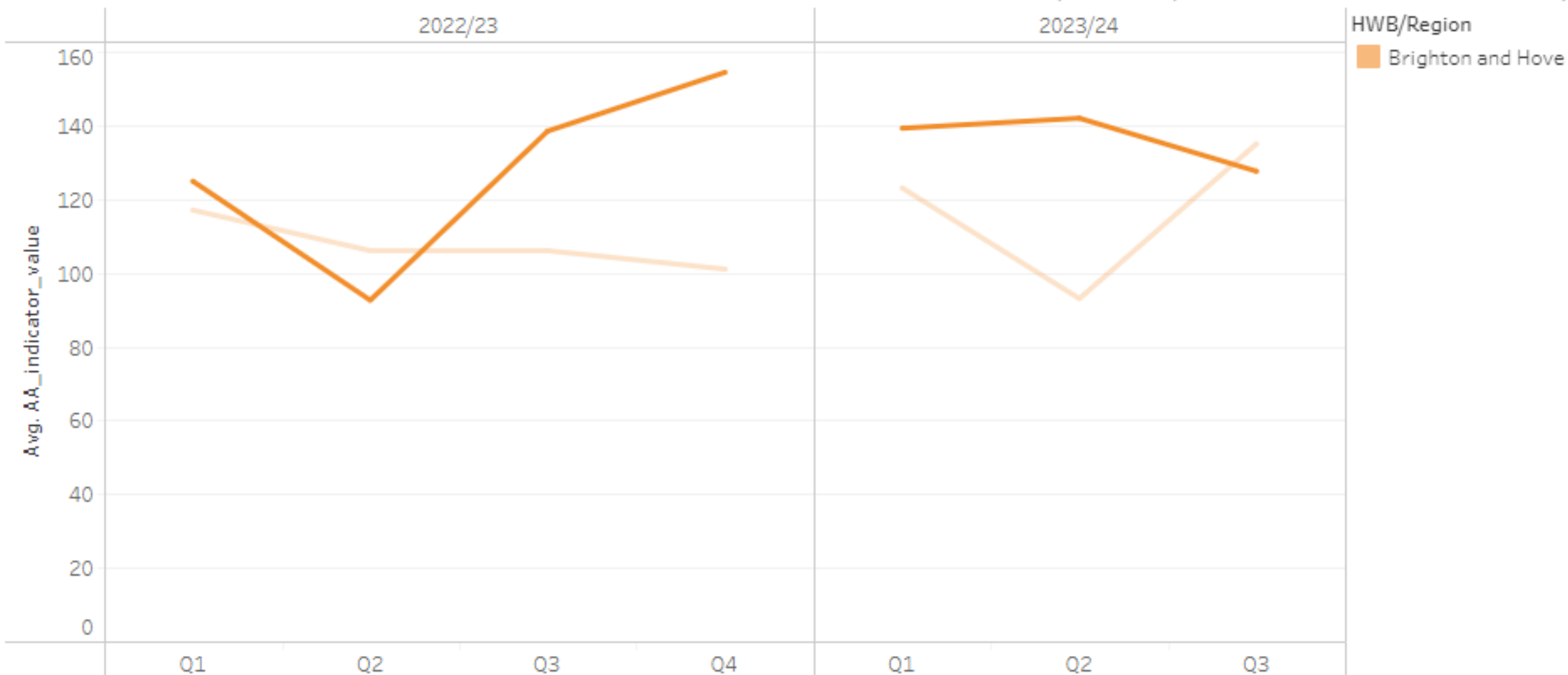

Avoidable Admissions - Actuals vs Plan

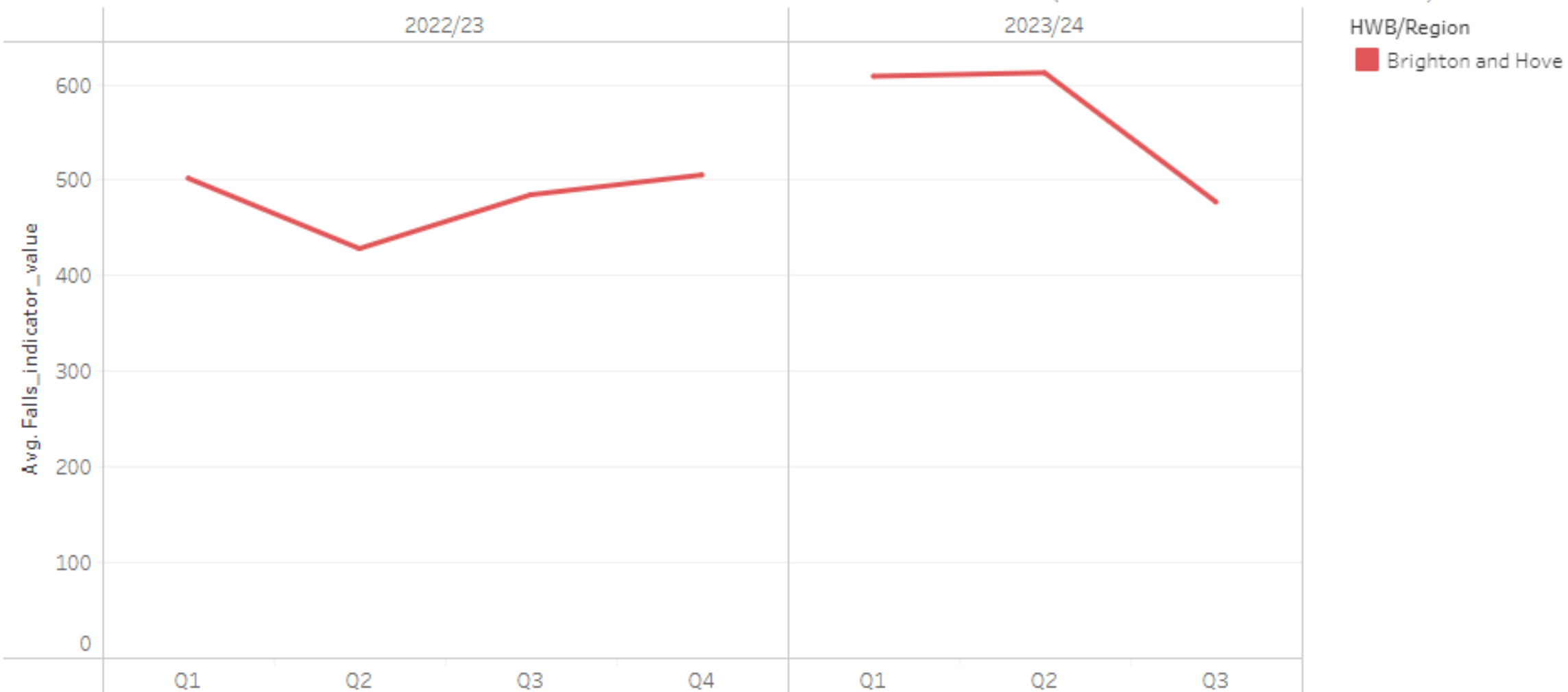

Falls - Actuals vs Plan

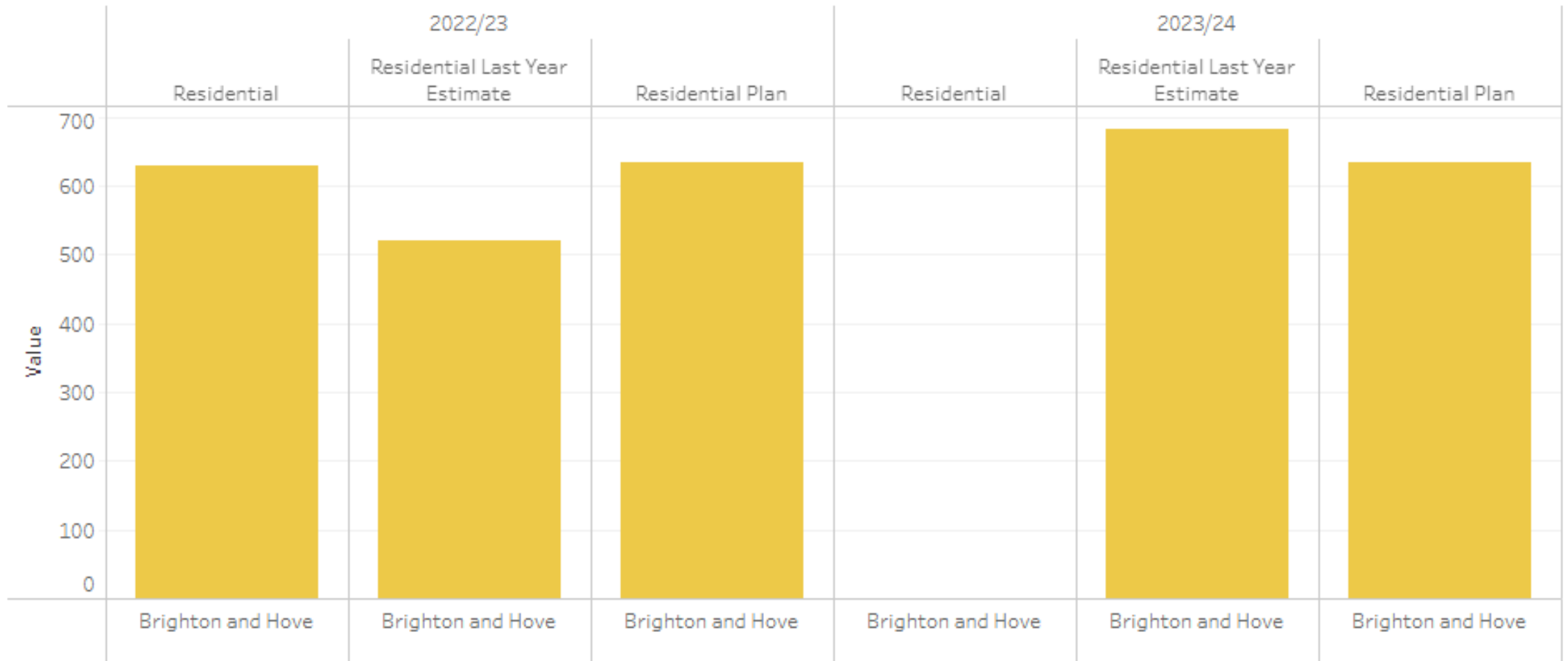
Emergency hospital admissions due to falls in people aged 65 and over directly age standardised rate per 100,000.

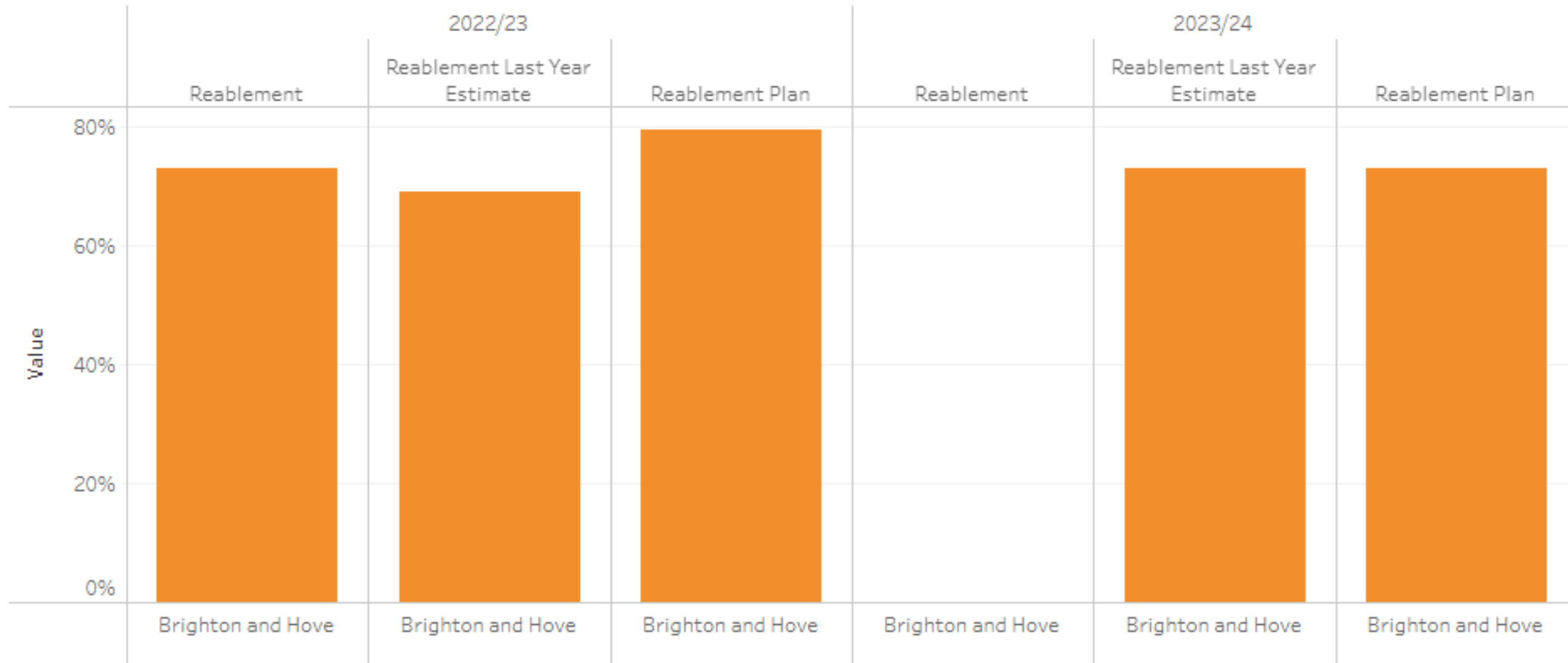
