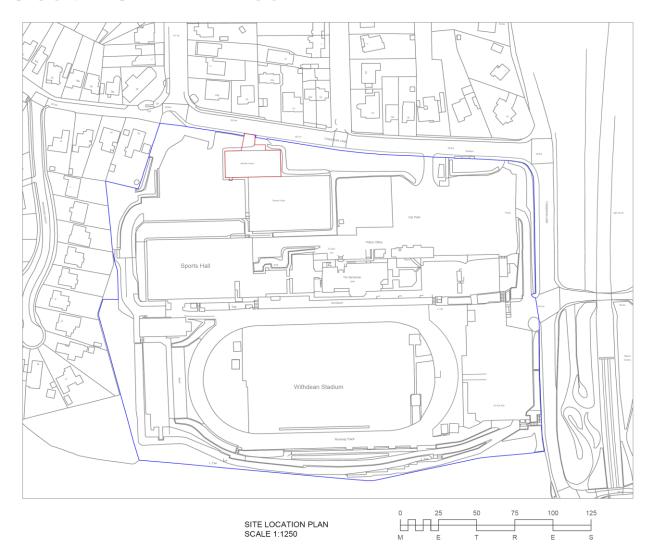


Application Description

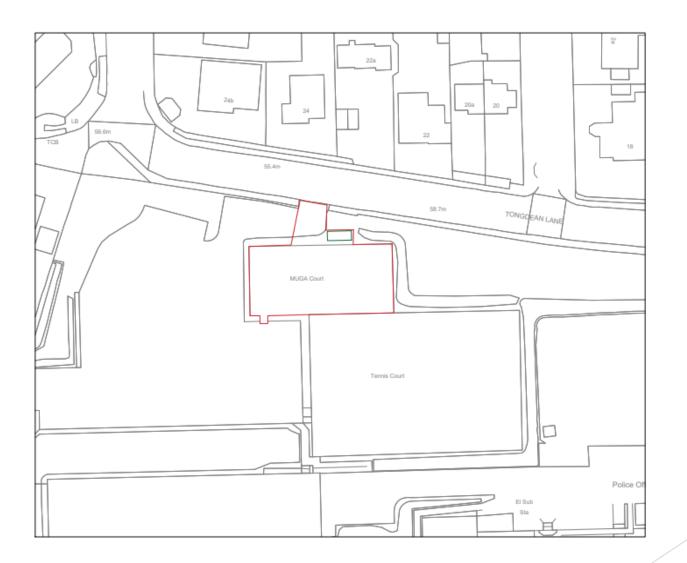

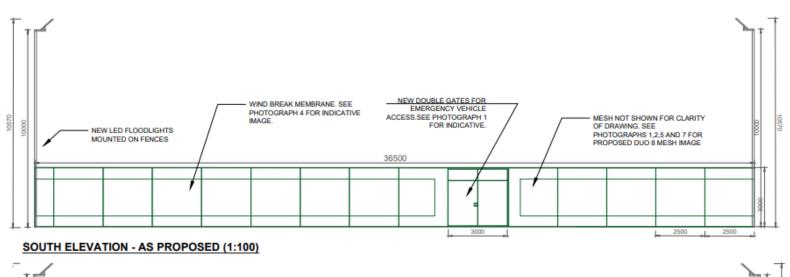

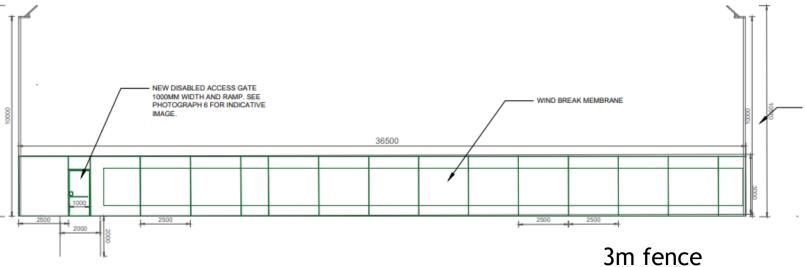

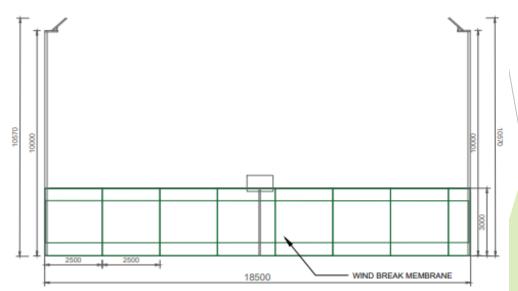

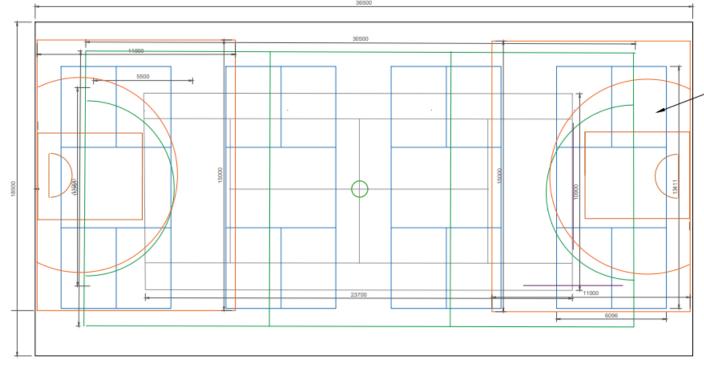

MUGA COURT - PROPOSED DEMARCATION LINES (1:100)

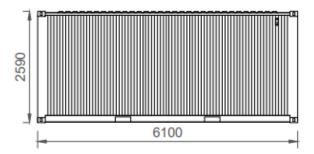

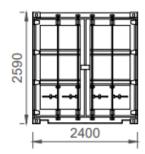

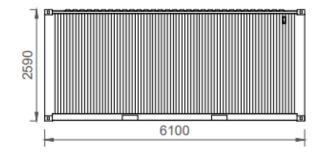
NORTH ELEVATION - AS PROPOSED (1:50)



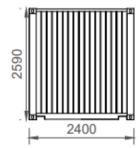
EAST ELEVATION

Representations

- 1. **Fifteen (15)** letters of <u>objection</u> have been received, summarised as follows:
- Previous padel court caused nuisance, pickleball courts are also noisy
- No noise impact assessment carried out
- Inappropriate use for the area
- Visual impact of proposed new surface and container
- Damage to trees
- Inconsistencies on the drawings
- Surface water flooding concerns
- Loss of property value
- 2. Sixteen (16) letters of support have been received, summarised as follows:
- Improved sports facilities welcomed
- Pickleball is a growing sport and there are no other suitable facilities in the city

- Design and Appearance
- ▶ Impact on neighbouring amenity



Conclusion and Planning Balance

- ► The proposed upgrading and refurbishment of the existing MUGA would accord with the Policy CP17 of the City Plan Part One and is supported in principle
- The proposed replacement fencing and surfacing would match those on the neighbouring outdoor sports pitches and are considered to be acceptable in terms of design and appearance.
- ► The proposed storage container would be located to the northern side of the MUGA, with the boundary fence, earth bank and mature trees providing visual screening.
- ► The proposed floodlights would be of the same height and similar slender appearance to the existing columns



Conclusion and Planning Balance

- ► The existing MUGA is floodlit and is an established feature of the Sports Complex that can already be used for the playing of outdoor sports
- ► The proposed development does not include any enlargement or repositioning of the MUGA
- ► The proposed hours of use align with the existing opening hours of the Sports Complex
- ► The proposed development therefore would not result in increased activity or noise compared to that which could take place on the site currently
- A condition is recommended to secure further detail of the proposed floodlight luminaires to ensure that light spill is kept to within acceptable levels.
