




## **Map of Application Site**





### **Location Plan**








#### **Existing & Proposed Lower Ground Floor**









#### **Existing & Proposed Ground Floor**








## **Existing & Proposed 1st Floor**







### Representations

► Nine objections received including from Council from British Archaeology. Issues raised:

- ► Removal of historic features from within building including marble fireplace, stained glass windows, doorways and doors, mouldings, original wall.
- ► Factual inaccuracies within Heritage Statement.
- ▶ No consultation with tenants/residents of flats.



#### **Conclusion and Recommendation**

- ► Works would be entirely internal main historic significance of Listed Building is exterior which would be untouched;
- ► Works clarified by agent to confirm historic features including fireplaces, stained glass windows, mouldings would not be affected;
- ► Heritage Officer satisfied that works would maintain the historic features of the building and overall be beneficial through removing partition walls that currently divide up historic spaces.
