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Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives:

a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 10)

All staff will be provided with training about the licensing objectives and their responsibilities age verification and licensing offences. Details of the training will be recorded and will be refreshed at regular intervals.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

A CCTV system shall be maintained at the premises. An incident book will be used to record details of any incidents in the premises that relate to the licensing objectives, in particular any refusal of sale of alcohol. Signage will be displayed at the exit of premises that advise customers that they must not take open alcoholic drinks from premises.

c) Public safety

All safety matters at the premises are adequately covered by statutory provisions such as The Health and Safety at Work (etc) Act 1974 The Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

A telephone number for premises will be displayed , that will be visible from the exterior of the building in the event that contact needs to be made with the staff to deal with any issues that might arise from the licensable activity.

e) The protection of children from harm

A Challenge 25 scheme will be adopted. Customers who appear to be under 25 years of age will be required to prove their age when purchasing alcohol. Suitable forms of identification will be a passport, „Pas“ card or other identification recognised by the licensing authority in its statement of licensing policy.
