M Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives:

a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 10)

We are a responsible business who takes seriously the licensing objectives and the Council's Statement of Policy for the Licensing Act 2003.

It is appreciated that this application for late-night refreshment is for a premises is located within the Brighton Cumulative Impact Zone (CIZ) and there is a 'rebuttal presumption'.

However, this an exceptional application where the applicant is proposing a number of steps to ensure that there is no impact on CIZ. The applicant has provided some additional conditions (attached) to support the application and the licensing objectives.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

On busy days Friday, Saturday and Bank Holidays etc, a SIA door man will be deployed from the hours of 21:00 till close to control entry and prevent any gathering of people or loitering.

Premises will be actively involved with safety initiatives such as 'Ask for Angela'

c) Public safety

We have a consultant Environmental Health Officer who has advised us on public safety. We have a full stocked first aid kit and trained in first aid. Our business will not give rise to a public safety risk. We will have an automatic fire detection system and ample fire evacuation points.

Firefighting equipment to be strategically placed throughout the premises. Emergency lighting, training of staff to deal with public safety and first aid.

Staff to receive Vulnerability training

d) The prevention of public nuisance

No music or other entertainment will be provided

We will display and encourage signage and encourage patrons to leave and conduct themselves respectively.

The premises already provides and will continue to provide refuse facilities and undertake an end of shift litter pick to enhance the area.
