10. (Contd.)

This was later amended to include that part of the garden up to the northern boundary of the proposed right of way and was later extended again to include the proposed right of way and an area beyond it. Negotiations with the developer Cherrywood were initially on the basis that a licence would be granted and then a 10 year lease. At Cherrywoods insistance the gardens (including the proposed right of way) were included in the 125 year lease granted.

Whilst my involvement with the property has been limited to the last 5 years or so my understanding is that access had not been restricted prior to the granting of the lease to Cherrywood in 2002.
