

## APPENDIX A

#### LICENSING OBJECTIVES

Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives:

a) General – all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e)

List here steps you will take to promote all four licensing objectives together.

The premises are to be used for providing restaurant facilities.  
Alcohol will be served with or without a meal.  
Children (usually accompanied by adults) will be allowed into the premises to experience a family friendly and safe environment.  
The services provided will be family oriented and child friendly.  
There will be recorded background music to enhance the eating experience for diners and on various occasions there may be entertainment such as a DJ, Live Band or Karaoke.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

Alcohol will be served mainly as an accompaniment to meals, but will also be consumed without a meal.  
Alcohol will only be served for consumption on the premises.  
There will be a CCTV system in the entrance and the bar.

c) Public safety

The premises will be carefully managed by the Designated Premises Supervisor and a management team one of whom intend to be on the premises at all times when preparing and serving food and alcohol.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

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The supply of alcohol will be restricted as stated above.  
The premises will be managed and supervised at all times to provide a family orientated and child friendly environment.  
The premises are in an area with a high commercial concentration. Any noise emanating from the restaurant should not effect the general public or housing. On occasions when there will be music or dancing, there should be no effect on the local population.

e) The protection of children from harm

Alcohol will not be served to children who will invariably be accompanied by an adult.  
The premises will provide a family orientated and child friendly environment.  
Children of 16 or 17 years of age accompanied by an adult may be allowed beer,wine or cider with a table meal. Anyone who looks under the age of 21 will be asked to produce proof of age.
