ON BUSY DAYS, WE WILL HAVE 2 STAFF ON IN THE LATE EVENINGS. ALCOHOL WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO BE CONSUMED ON THE VICINITY OF THE PREMISES. THERE WILL BE A PANIC BUTTON & TELEPHONE BEHIND THE COUNTER

c) Public safety

THERE IS A CCTV TO POLICE STANDARDS THAT WILL COVER THE DOOR ENTRANCE & ALCOHOL SALES AREA. NO ALCOHOL WILL BE ALLOWED TO BE DRUNK IN THE VICINITY OF PREMISES.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

SUITABLE SIGN AT DOOR EXIT TO REQUEST CO-OPERATION TO MAKE AS LITTLE NOISE AS POSSIBLE WHEN LEAVING. PATRONS WILL BE ASKED NOT TO HANGAROUND & TALK OUTSIDE THE PREMISES AND ASKED ~~NOT~~ TO LEAVE QUIETLY. STAFF WILL BE AWARE OF NOISE THAT COULD DISTURB NEIGHBOURS AND WILL KEEP IT TO A MINIMUM

e) The protection of children from harm

THE ACCEPTABLE IDs ARE PASSPORTS, DRIVING LICENCES WITH PHOTOGRAPH AND "PASS" HOLOGRAPHIC GROUP PROOF OF AGE CARD.
