

WRITTEN QUESTIONS FROM MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC

A period of not more than fifteen minutes shall be allowed for questions submitted by a member of the public who either lives or works in the area of the authority at each ordinary meeting of the Committee.

Every question shall be put and answered without discussion, but the person to whom a question has been put may decline to answer. The person who asked the question may ask one relevant supplementary question, which shall be put and answered without discussion.

The following written question has been received from a member of the public.

(a) Mr M Strong

“Transport is of great importance to Brighton & Hove. The City Transport Partnership has ensured engagement with the wider community, helping to deliver a broad consensus about transport and enabling key projects to be developed.

However the last CTP meeting was cancelled, removing any opportunity for a discussion of issues around the Capital Programme. Furthermore, the proposed merger of the Environment & Transport Committees has created major concerns about the future of the partnership and engagement on transport issues.

Does the Council remain committed to the CTP and to full and open engagement with community representatives on transport issues?”
