## Brighton \& Hove City Council Response:

A number of the comments above relate to issues outside of the Highway licensing System (Items 5, 16, 32,50) or placements allowable under the 2008-2009 rules, but which would be addressed by the measures recommended in the report (Items 3,10, 18, $20,24,25,26,27,29,30,37,46,48,53)$.

Other comments relate to licensed sites where no access problems are mentioned or where the activities are permitted and will remain so under the proposed changes. Certain statements are at odds with later findings (and common practice) at the locations mentioned.

Note that this survey took place towards the very end of the licensing year. As a result a number of "new" businesses (i.e. businesses awaiting licensing or approaches to license) or sites where discs have vanished \& not yet been replaced are only to be expected.
